Please pray for our schools as they reopen this week—and as the slow release from lockdown begins (praying that we will move forward slowly yet steadily) our thoughts turn to Easter.

It feels really important that we gather and worship together on Easter Day... poignantly the story of resurrection and new life begins whilst it is still dark...

Following discussions with both PCCs we have come up with a plan:

Palm Sunday there is planned a Service of Readings and Music that will take us into Holy Week Good Friday there will be some kind of outdoor service... perhaps a walking Stations of the Cross between the two churches.

Easter Day we hope there will be a Dawn Eucharist at Christ Church—out of doors in the churchyard. Later in the morning a Eucharist at St. Mary's and possibly also at Christ Church

In the evening there is planned a Sung Evensong at Christ Church and possibly also a Eucharist at St. Mary's.

It is still a little uncertain about what it is safe to do and we are planning for these services to be ticketed as they were at Christmas to ensure that we can accommodate people safely.

Annual Meetings

The meetings will be held as follows:

Christ Church will be on April 25 and St. Mary's on 2 May after the 10am service.

Of course this is subject to Govt regulations and may need to change.

At the last Annual Meetings we agreed to allow postal voting and in view of the fact that people may well still be shielding, we are making it possible for churchwardens and PCC members to be nominated by post too. This process will all take more time than usual and so it is important to begin thinking about things now.
